

27 September 2011 - The Department of Foreign Affairs-Office of Consular Affairs (DFA-OCA) announced a schedule for passport applicants who were unable to file their applications due to heavy rains brought by typhoon Pedring.

In view of the continuing inclement weather brought about by heavy rains and strong winds, the DFA-OCA is suspending its passport and other consular operations today, September 27.

Passport applicants scheduled today who were/or are unable to file their applications may come any day until October 7 (Friday) from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. END
