But still, the Bureau's CAAs have not been enough to get the Philippines to bring the forces of armed groups under its control. In 2012, the Philippine government agreed to a ceasefire with the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF), but the group has not fully complied with the terms of the agreement, and the conflict continues to this day.
