



6 March 2013 – The Philippine Embassy in Madrid, in cooperation with *Tahanan* (the umbrella organization of most of the Filipino community organizations in Madrid), organized a Eucharistic Mass to commemorate the 27<sup>th</sup>

Anniversary of the EDSA People Power Revolution on February 24 at the *Nuestro Señora del Espino* in Madrid.

The Eucharistic Mass featured special petitions to help Filipinos keep the spirit of EDSA alive, community singing of *Handog ng Pilipino sa Mundo*, and a short speech by Philippine Ambassador to Spain Carlos C. Salinas.

In his speech, Ambassador Salinas noted the achievements of the Filipino people during EDSA and imparted to the Community the good news about the current state of the Philippine economy. He also took the opportunity to thank the members of the community for their continued contribution to national development.

The Embassy also organized screenings of the two (2) video documentaries on EDSA, namely, *Ninoy: The Heart and Soul*

and

at the Consular Section of the Chancery and the Philippine Overseas Labor Office-Overseas Workers' Welfare Administration (POLO-OWWA) Office from February 25 to March 01.
