

19 March 2013 - The Philippine Embassy in Riyadh successfully conducted its sixth mobile consular outreach services or Embassy-on-Wheels (EOW) for the year. The EOW was held at the Al Jazeera International School in Al Khobar's Rakah District from



March 07 to 08.

The four-member EOW Team, led by Vice Consul Red Genotiva, facilitated 405 e-passport applications, 32 passports extensions, 13 registrations of birth, and 160 notarials, five (5) authentication of documents with 330 new e-passports released.

A total of 945 Filipinos were served during the EOW in Al Khobar.
