FILIPINOS WIN AWARDS IN 2 BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS IN GUAM

22 November 2006 – Philippine Consul General in Guam Teresita L. Mendiola reported to the Department of Foreign Affairs that Filipino bowlers won top awards at the 5th Guam Open Tournament held from 30 October to 4 November 2006, and the 20th Intercity Bowling Championship held on 6 to 11 November 2006, at the Guam Central Lanes Bowling Center.

Filipino bowler Sixto Sengson, who showed consistency during the games and garnered a total score of 3481, took the top spot, claiming the Guam Open

Masters Title. Sengson won the Championship Trophy and a cash price of US\$4,000.00, while Manila resident Purvis Granger took the second place, winning a cash price of US\$2,000.00.

In the Classified Finals of the 5th Guam Open Tournament, top seeded Filipino bowler Edgar Barroga also won the Championship, claiming the Guam Open Classic Master Title.

In the 20th Intercity Bowling Championship, Filipino women bowlers bagged the Gold and the Silver prizes. The team from Paranaque, Philippines, headed by Liza Clutario ruled the Women's Division. Her teammates were Soek Kim Yap, Lucy Cheng and Cecilia Yap. The silver went to the team from Pasay City composed of Sheena Go, Kathleen Ann Lopez, Amy Leong, and Liza Ponce-Enrile.
