PHILIPPINE CONSULATE GENERAL, GUANGZHOU GRABS 4 MAJOR AWARDS AT ASEAN FRIENDSHIP BOWLING TOURNAMENT

28 May 2007 – Acting Head of Post Alex G. Chua of the Philippine Consulate General in Guangzhou, PROC reported to the Department of Foreign Affairs that the Philippine team at the ASEAN Friendship Bowling Tournament held at the Tianhe Bowling Stadium on 25 May 2007 won four awards at the tournament, including the Team Championship and the Rotating Over-All Championship trophies.

“Mr. Rolando Cabañero grabbed the Champion trophy for the Men's Category; Ms. Evelyn Padalhin got the Champion trophy for the Women's Category; and Ms. Amalia Abadilla was the first runner-up,” Acting Consul General Chua said.

“Among the present ASEAN Consular Corps in Guangzhou, the Philippines holds the longest running over-all championship record as well as in all of the three events,” he added.

Acting Consul General Chua reported that Mr. Harimawan Sujitno, Consul General of Indonesia, officially opened the tournament, which was participated by six ASEAN Consulates in Guangzhou, namely Indonesia (tournament host), Malaysia, Thailand, Singapore, Vietnam and the Philippines. END
